Document information

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The project

Nowadays, digital progress has ushered in a new era in which low-skilled adults tend to be left behind or fall into technological "traps" younger generations born "engulfed" with technology can easily avoid. Digital illiteracy poses other obstacles for adults, whether in their everyday lives or in their work and social environment. In addition, it is widely recognized that adults tend to avoid this educational process, since it is generally believed that the time for "attending school" has long passed, and a significant number of people are taking the first steps to improve their skills. The aim of this project is to carry out a series of training activities in which the institutes involved will be able to share and localize the teaching methods / tools used at local level, compare the differences and find the advantages of integrating each methodology / tool into their own activities.

The Survey

This report refers to the participants' satisfaction over the training course on "Game-based learning, critical thinking and information filtering" held in Sofia, Bulgaria from 27th September to 1st October. 9 participants from Czech Republic, Italy, Spain and Turkey joined the LTTA. A tool in the form of a survey has been developed to measure the satisfaction level of trainees on several aspects of the LTTA, such as relevance, quality, preparedness of the trainers and future applicability of the course content. The questionnaire ([link](#)) was delivered during the last day of training, via QR code. Participants scanned it and filled the form providing precious feedback. Eight responses were received in total and analysed.

The Results

The questionnaire, developed by Prism impresa sociale srl was prepared in the form of a list of satisfaction items, posed as questions, related to the criteria retained for the evaluation of this activity, to be assessed using a variable rating scale, as per level of respondents' agreement with the respective statement. A total of 11 items was assessed using a variable scale of value and three open questions were included as well, so as participants could give personal meaning to their answers and include any other possible aspects. The full list of items with relative graphs attached is displayed below.

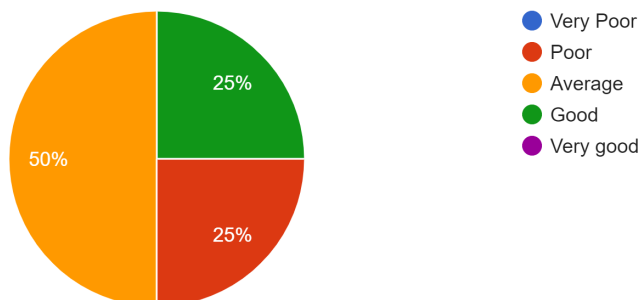

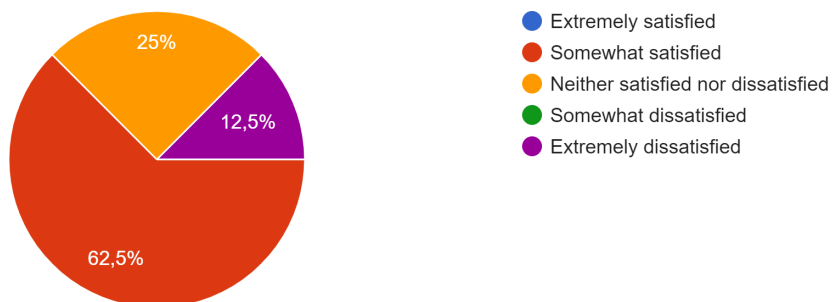

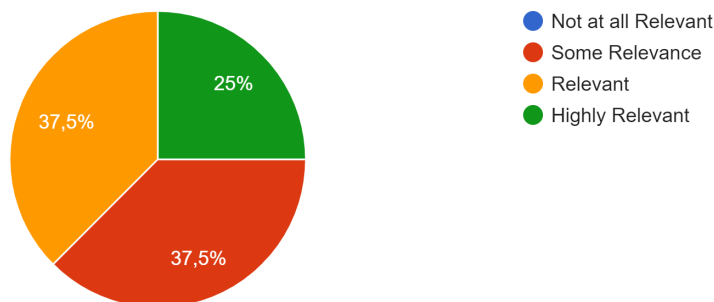

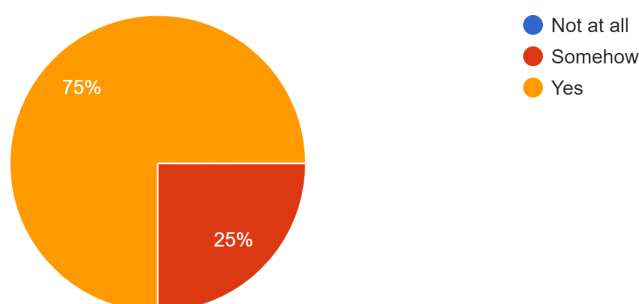

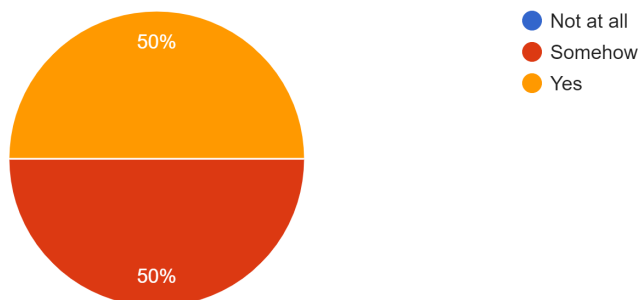
5. Do you feel your expressed opinion was valued during the training?

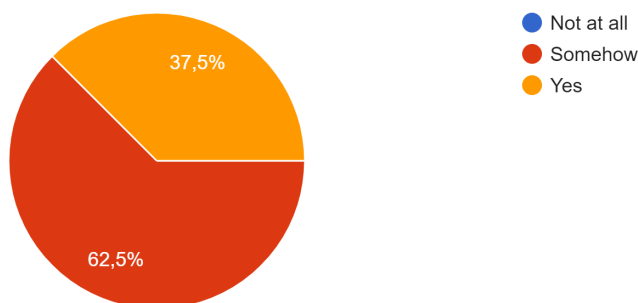


6. Did the facilitators give adequate explanations to questions asked?

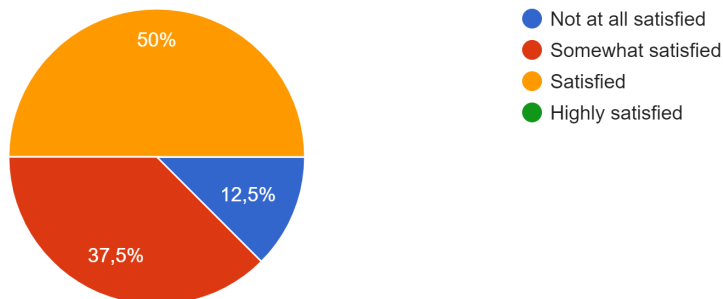


7. How satisfied are you with the trainers' clarity of explanations?

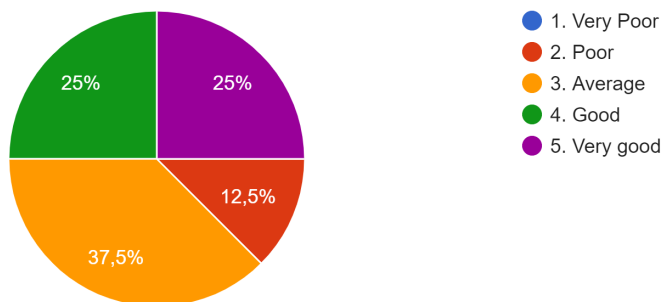


8. Please rate the trainers' level of knowledge of the subject.

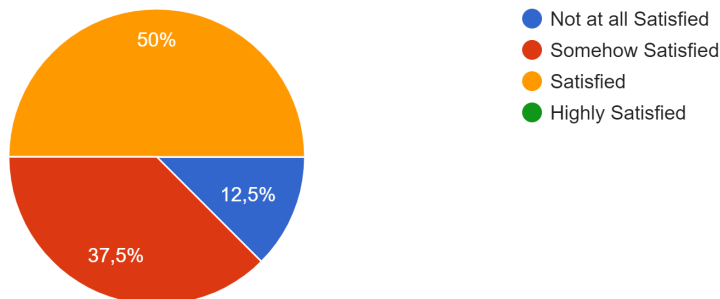


9. How satisfied were you with the trainers' style of presentation?

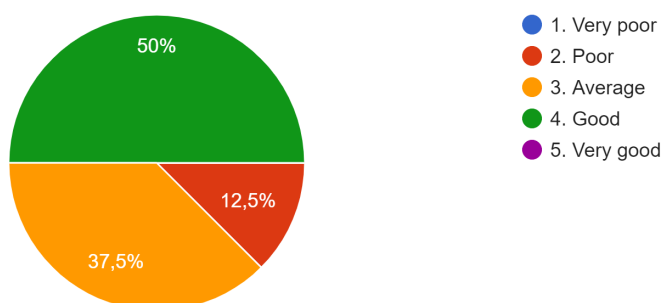

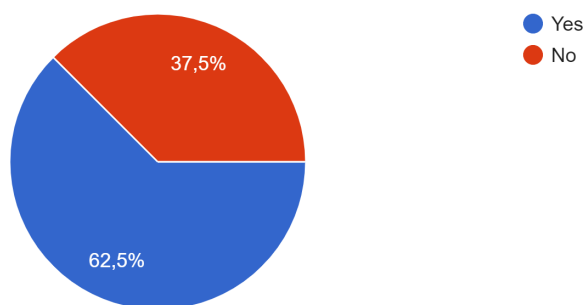
